

Do you go to Sheetz without first purchasing a Sheetz card from NCCS? Do you do your grocery shopping at Walmart, Giant Eagle or Bi Lo without first purchasing a gift card from NCCS for those purchases? If you do, ask yourself why? **SCRIP** is one of the **mandatory** fundraisers that we do at NCCS, and it is the **easiest** fundraiser to participate in. There is nothing to sell

and we are not asking you to purchase anything that you wouldn't normally buy; items such as gas and food. We only ask that you change the way that you buy these items by purchasing gift cards from NCCS first and then use those gift cards to make your purchases. It costs you nothing extra; if you plan to purchase \$25 Sheetz card from NCCS. We receive a percentage of the purchase of your card and you still get \$25 in gas. It is a winning situation for everyone. SCRIP helps keep the cost of tuition down. We have many dedicated SCRIP buyers, but some make little or no effort. Everyone uses gas and food daily. Please consider using SCRIP from NCCS if you don't, and certainly continue to use SCRIP if you met your goal.
